2. Log In Assistance

If you can not remember your username, password or don't remember ever receiving an invitation from the Pack (refer to the first part of Section 3 below), please go to the public page of our website, click on the "Contact Our Pack" button and let us know.

When you first join the Pack, one of our webmasters will enter your initial name, scout's name and rank, and email contact information. 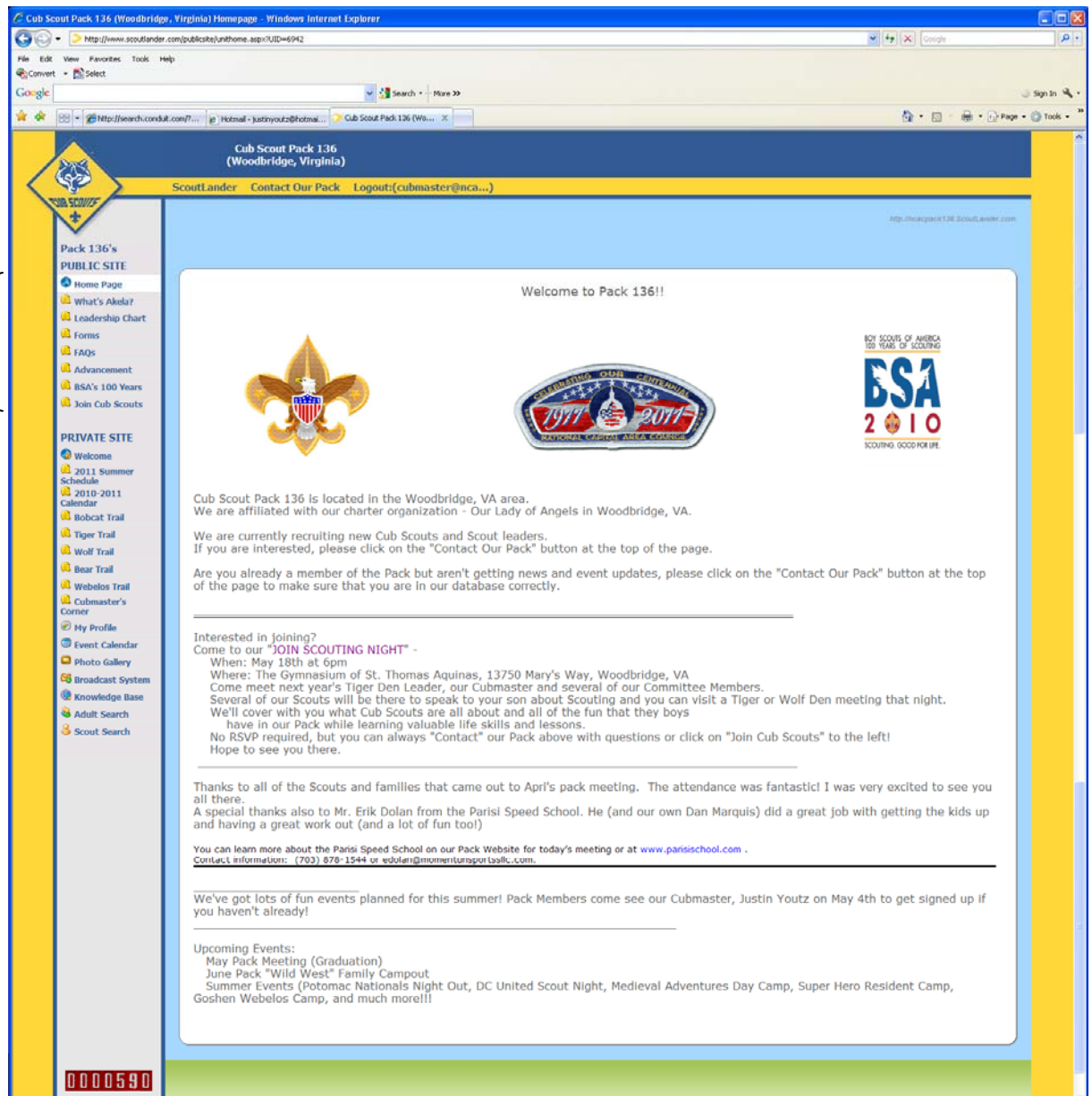
5. Basic Navigation

Last night, we filled most of the open positions, but a few key positions remain:

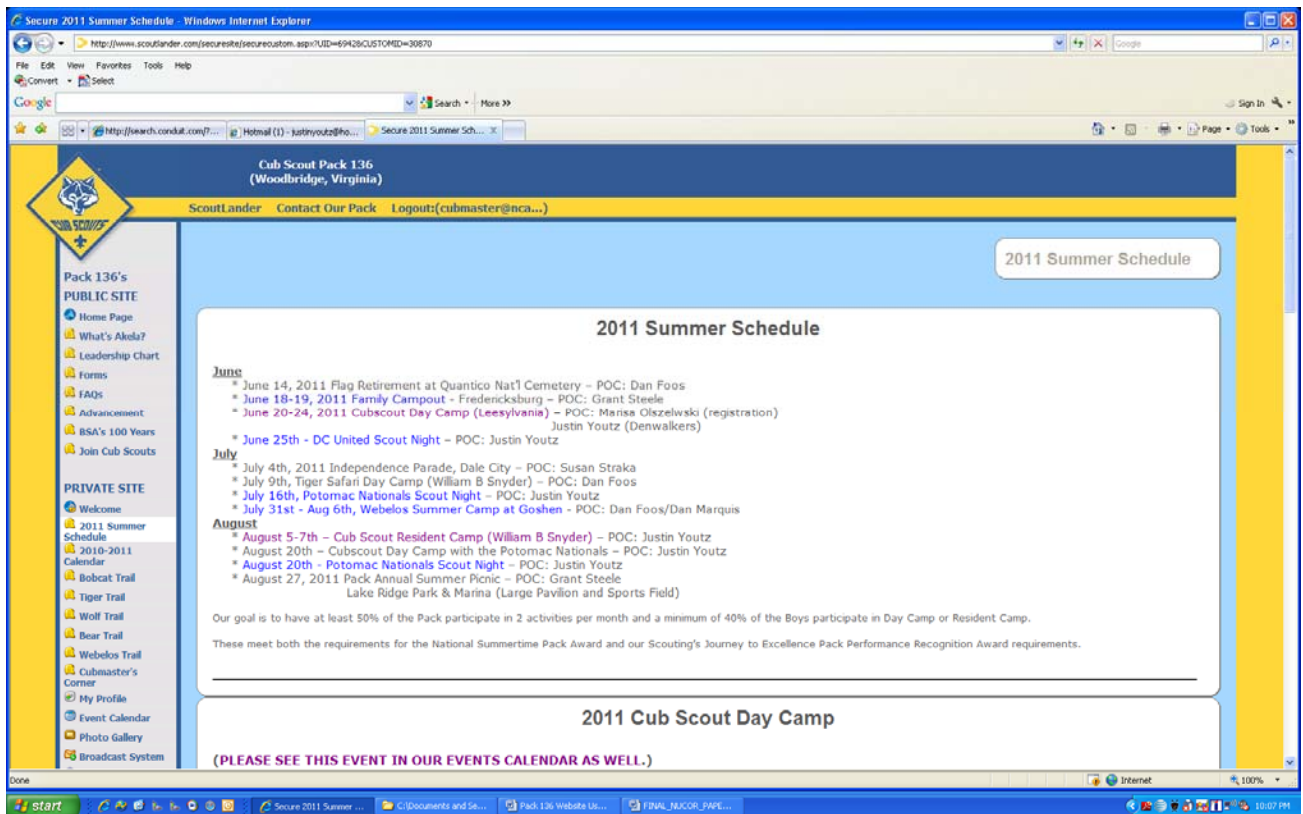

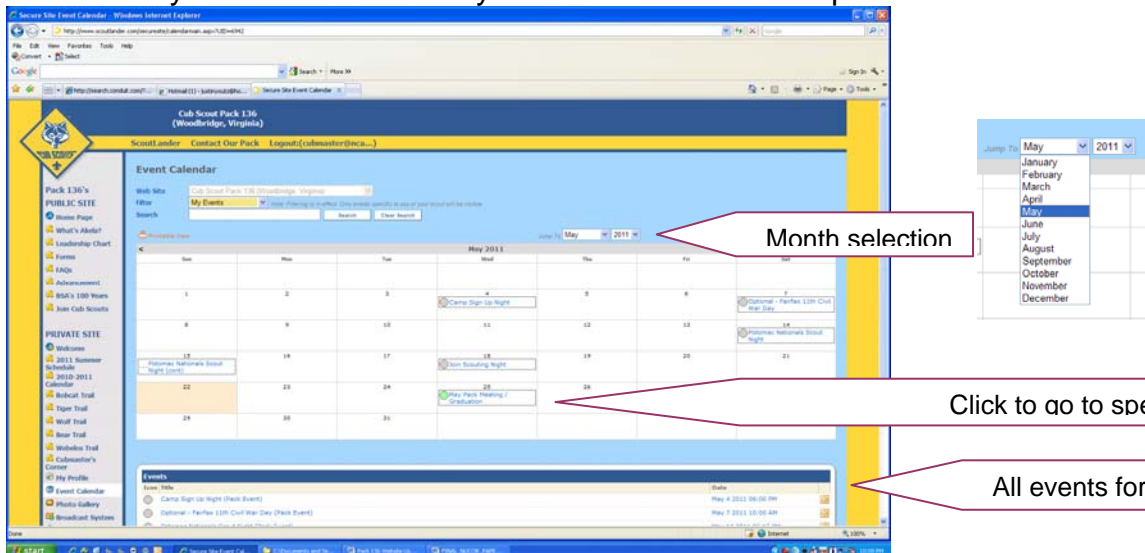
6. Event Calendar Navigation

The calendar only shows one month at a time.

You can change the month by selecting the arrow to the right of the month and then picking which month you want to go to.

Click directly on an event to take you to the details and RSVP for that event.



Once you click on an event, you will be taken to the details of the event. Here, it will list if the event is for the Pack or specific Den activity, the contact person, time, location and any other important information including download material.
